FAQs

What are different ways to give to the endowment?

- Give cash, stock, bonds, mutual funds, real estate, life insurance, beneficiary designations of insurance policies, IRA/401k accounts, or other assets.
- Give a check payable to Lincoln Community Foundation, 215 Centennial Mall South, Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68508. Write “ _____ (*fund name*)” on the check memo line.
- Donate online at www.lcf.org by clicking the “Donate” button on the top section of the webpage. Complete the online form and under “Designation:” select “Other LCF Fund” and type _____ (*fund name*) in the drop down box.
- Donate stock, other securities, insurance or real estate by calling Lincoln Community Foundation at 402-474-2345 and ask for Paula Metcalf, Chip DeBuse or Tracy Edgerton.
- Make a gift in your will to “Lincoln Community Foundation” for the _____ (*fund name*). *(Always seek advice from your own legal professional.)*
- Talk to your insurance broker or financial advisor about including the _____ (*fund name*) at Lincoln Community Foundation on the Beneficiary Designation forms for your stock account, insurance policy, or retirement accounts. *(Always coordinate beneficiary designations with your overall estate plan.)*
